Eligibility: 199 % of Federal Poverty Level.

- 1) If patient is a veteran, he/she must contact the Veteran's Outreach office to determine eligibility for Veteran's Benefits. Patient must present a letter of ineligibility.
- 2) Proof of Income: Current employment will be verified. Please bring three months of pay stubs. Proof of any public assistance received (food stamps, etc.)
- 3) Proof of Residence: Current utility bill, phone bill, rent receipt, etc.
- 4) Photo ID or driver's license
- 5) Social Security Card
- 6) Any Insurance Cards
- 7) Most recent tax return
- 8) Letter of denial from human services (optional)

Initial Contact:

New patients should contact the clinic at 330-364-1853. The staff/volunteer will assist you in determining your eligibility. All required documents must be presented at the eligibility appointment. Eligibility will be reviewed yearly. Patients are required to notify staff of any changes in their situations that would affect their eligibility to receive care from the clinic.

Services:

Tuscarawas Clinic for the Working Uninsured provides free primary health services including:

- Health assessment/treatment
- Health education services
- Laboratory, x-rays, other testing as deemed appropriate by the physician
- Outpatient services
- Referral services for specialty care
